

## 5 Days 4 Nights Hong Kong & Shenzhen Tour Package



### Day 1 Kuala Lumpur – Hong Kong (no meal)

Assemble at the airport for the greatest moment which you have been waiting for, Hong Kong & Shenzhen Tour. Upon arrival you will be guided by the tour guide to the hotel check in and you will have your own sweetest time discovering the cultures and traditions of another world on earth with lifestyles and happenings all over the place of Hong Kong.

### Day 2 Hong Kong – Shenzhen (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

You will have a full-day city tour and first stop the **Repulse Bay**. In 1841, the bay was used as a base by pirates and caused serious concern to foreign **merchant ships** trading with **China**. The pirates were subsequently repulsed by the **British Fleet**; hence the name. Another theory holds that the bay was named after **HMS Repulse** which was stationed at the bay at one point.

In the 1910s, Repulse Bay was developed into a beach, and the Repulse Bay Hotel was built in 1920. To attract swimmers, a bus route from **Central** to Repulse Bay was created, and now stands as one of Hong Kong's oldest bus routes. During the **Battle of Hong Kong** in **World War II**, Repulse Bay was an important strategic location. And will proceed to **Aberdeen floating village** (Chinese: 香港仔水上人家) is located at the **Aberdeen** Harbour in the **Southern District** of **Hong Kong**. The harbour contains approximately 600 **junks**, which house an estimated 6,000 people. Since the 19th century, Aberdeen has emerged as one of the most important fishing ports in Hong Kong. Now in Aberdeen, as the catering and tourism industries are on the rise, so is the demand for seafood. In the past two decades, the population of the Aberdeen Floating Village community has decreased due to rapid fisheries development in Guangdong and the increase in operating costs of the fishing industry in Hong Kong. Instead of living on the boat permanently, now the majority of the boat people only fish on the boat during the day. Soon after you will be led to Jewellery shop, Chinese Herbs Shop. After that proceed to Shenzhen by train. Arrival Shenzhen transfer to hotel.

### Day 3 Shenzhen (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed for City Tour. Visit Splendid China and Cultural Village Tour with Show **Shenzhen** (Chinese: 深圳市; pinyin: *Shēnzhèn shì*; IPA: [ʃən'tʃənʃi]) is a city of **sub-provincial** administrative status in southern China's **Guangdong** province, situated immediately north of **Hong Kong**. Owing to China's economic liberalization under the policies of reformist leader **Deng Xiaoping**, the area became China's first—and arguably one of the most successful—**Special Economic Zones**.

Shenzhen's novel and modern cityscape is the result of the vibrant economy made possible by rapid **foreign investment** since the late 1970s, when it was a small fishing village. Since then, foreign nationals have invested more than **US\$30 billion** for building factories and forming **joint ventures**. It is now reputedly one of the fastest growing cities in the world. Being southern mainland China's major financial centre, Shenzhen is home to the **Shenzhen Stock Exchange** as well as the headquarters of numerous high-tech companies.

Shenzhen is also the second **busiest port** in **mainland China**, ranking only after **Shanghai**. **Overseas Chinese Town** or **Huaqiaocheng** in **Chinese** (**simplified Chinese**: 华侨城) is a famous scenic spot in **Nanshan District, Shenzhen, Guangdong, China**, near **Huaqiaocheng Station** in the **Shenzhen Metro**. It integrates traditional **Chinese culture**, **Chinese folk culture** with the World cultural essences, featuring **theme parks** including "**Splendid China**" (**simplified Chinese**: 锦绣中华), "**Chinese Folk Culture Village**" (**simplified Chinese**: 民族文化村), "**Window of the World**" (**simplified Chinese**: 世界之窗) and "**Happy Valley**" (**simplified Chinese**: 欢乐谷).<sup>[1][2]</sup> It is currently owned and operated by **Shenzhen Overseas Chinese Town Holding Company**.
